Entry Conditions and Eligibility:

- ◆ Entry will be online at www.pastelartists.ca Entry is not confirmed until submission is complete and payment is received
- ◆ Open to all artists working in soft pastel
- ◆ A maximum of 3 digital images (jpg), by any one artist, may be entered.
- ◆ All entries must be for sale. All sales are subject to a 35% commission
- ◆ All works must be original and created within the **last 3 years, and not shown in any previous PAC show (online or physical show)**.
- ◆ Traditional soft pastels only—no oil pastels. The essential qualities of the painting must have been achieved with soft pastel and the final finishing layers of the painting must consist of predominantly soft pastel.
- ◆ Classroom or workshop work as well as copies of the work of other artists are not eligible
- ◆ Works created/painted on top of a base photo, print or other mechanical reproduction are not eligible.
- ◆ Works based on professional or published photographs are not eligible (Note: this includes calendar photos).
- ◆ Works based solely on photographs in the public domain or with creative commons licenses are **highly discouraged**, and the original photographer must be credited in the work's title. They may be subject to disqualification at the juror's or PAC's discretion.
- ◆ Failure to comply with these rules will result in the works being disqualified without notice or refund, and may result in the artist being barred from entering future PAC exhibitions.
- ◆ The Juror's decision is final.
- ◆ Your entry in this exhibition constitutes an agreement to all conditions as stated.

Purely Pastel

Entry Fees & Commission

- ◆ Entry fees are accepted through PayPal as part of the submission process.
- ◆ A non-refundable fee of \$20 per image or \$45 for 3 for PAC and PSEC members (PSEC members must supply proof of membership by email to Kathy Hildebrandt)
- ◆ A non-refundable fee of \$25 per image or \$60 for 3 for non members.
- ◆ The Federation of Canadian Artists will retain a commission of 35%. PAC will not retain any commission.

Image Specifications

- ◆ Digital files must be in JPG (jpeg) format. No other formats will be accepted. Only the image is to be visible, no frames, mats, etc. Make sure the image is level
- ◆ Image must be between 1200 and 2400 pixels on the longest side. File size should be no smaller than 500kb and no larger than 2MB.
- ◆ Each image file name must be as follows: **lastname, firstname, title, size.jpg** example: Smith, Mary, Spring Meadow, 14x18.jpg

How to Enter

- ◆ Entry is online at www.pastelartists.ca. Select the Call for Entry tab.
- ◆ You can also access the registration page directly at: <http://www.pastelartists.ca/onlineregistration>
- ◆ Ensure your images are correctly named as outlined above.
- ◆ Enter all your contact information as requested
- ◆ Ensure you select the **"Open Juried Physical"** option under the exhibition column.
- ◆ Enter the Title, Size, Price & Paper field for the image and upload the image. Repeat this for each image.

- ◆ Select the **PAC member** option if applicable.
- ◆ Select the **Create Registration** button when you are finished.
- ◆ You will be redirected to **PayPal** to pay your jury fee and complete your submission. Please Note: **You do not need a PayPal account , you can use your credit card.**
